

GRAPHIC DESIGN PRINCIPLES





1. Balance: Achieving visual equilibrium in the design by distributing elements evenly throughout the composition. Balance can be symmetrical (equal weight on both sides) or asymmetrical (unequal but visually balanced).



Maslow's Hierarchy of Needs

2. Hierarchy: Organizing elements within the design to establish a clear order of importance. Hierarchy helps guide the viewer's attention and emphasizes key elements such as headlines, subheadings, and call-to-action buttons.


3. Alignment: Ensuring that elements are visually aligned with each other to create a cohesive and organized layout. Proper alignment enhances readability and clarity within the design.

4. Contrast: Using differences in color, size, shape, texture, or value to create visual interest and highlight important elements. Contrast helps draw attention to focal points and improves readability.





5. Repetition: Consistently using recurring elements, such as colors, shapes, or typography styles, throughout the design to create unity and reinforce the overall visual theme.



6. Proximity: Grouping related elements together to establish visual relationships and improve organization. Proximity helps reduce clutter and makes the content more digestible for the viewer.

7. Typography: Selecting appropriate typefaces, font sizes, and spacing to enhance readability and convey the intended tone or message of the design. Typography also involves proper alignment and hierarchy of text elements.

8. Color Theory: Understanding the psychological effects and symbolism of different colors, as well as how they interact with each other, to evoke specific emotions or convey particular meanings within the design.
